You will only need to provide the number of teams at registration; we will ask for your students' names and t-shirt sizes later.



**MEET WITH YOUR TEAM:** Come up with your strategy – some teams divide and conquer (i.e., each student is responsible for their own portion of the guide and CD), other teams collaboratively review all the material together – there is no wrong way to prepare! Could the guide even serve as curriculum for your music appreciation course?
